

## **Parent/Member/Contract/Guidance** **COVID -19**

The safety of our members is of the highest priority. We therefore expect all members and parents/carers sending their children to a Mayflower outdoor rehearsal during the ease of lockdown to abide by this Contract for the safety of all. I agree to adhere to the following in order to reduce the risk of transmitting Covid-19 and to protect all at Mayflower. If I do not agree to the following, I understand that I/my child may not be able to attend Mayflower rehearsals during this time.

If I/my child or anybody in my household shows symptoms of the virus (temperature of 38°C or more, persistent/new cough, loss of taste or smell), I/my child will not attend a Mayflower rehearsal and seek testing for the household member immediately. I understand I/my child cannot return to Mayflower until a negative result is proven.

- I will ensure that I/my child washes my/their hands with soap before leaving the household for Mayflower rehearsals.
- I will ensure that any Mayflower equipment (i.e. flag, rifle etc) we are bringing with us has been thoroughly cleaned using anti-bacterial wipes (or similar) before leaving the household for Mayflower rehearsals.
- I will ensure that only ONE member of my household is at drop-off and pick-up and that, if I have to bring siblings, I will enforce Public Health England guidance with regards to them social-distancing.
- I will ensure that I am on time for my allocated drop-off and pick-up (avoiding cross-contamination).
- Any face-to-face communication will be minimal and at a safe social distance of 2m or more.
- I will ensure that a member of my household is available at all times in case I/my child needs to be collected due to sudden illness or because of their dangerous behaviour.
- I will ensure that all members of my household continue to follow advice from Public Health England with regards to social distancing.

- If I/my child is in the 'extremely clinical vulnerable' category, I will follow Public Health guidance and keep myself /them sheltered at home. If my child has medical needs that are considered to put me/them in a higher risk category (i.e., severe asthma), I understand that Mayflower cannot guarantee safe distancing at all times and therefore I/my child cannot attend these rehearsals
- I understand that if I do not comply with the above measures, me/my child may not be able to attend Mayflower rehearsals during this time
- I understand that there may not be toilet facilities available (but something we hope to be able to provide) and so all efforts will be made to ensure this will not be an issue for me/my child.

Further guidance:

1. Members will be in a Bubble of no more than 5 plus a member of staff
2. Staying in your Bubble will be enforced-no 'You might burst a bubble!!'
3. Members must only bring a cleaned water bottle
4. Members must be dressed in clean clothes that are also appropriate for physical exercise i.e., no flip-flops, onesies etc.
5. Members who purposely go against hygiene procedures i.e., refusing to wash hands or socially distance will be reminded but continuation of this behaviour will result in them being sent home
6. Members who purposely go against hygiene procedures i.e., coughing or sneezing at people will be excluded immediately
7. late arrivals and pick-ups put others at additional and unnecessary risk - please ensure you are punctual
